


Core Knowledge (Need to know) Vocabulary

Ocean	A large expanse of water.	
Earth	arth The planet that we live on.	
Continent	A large piece of land which could include lots of countries.	
Equator	An imaginary circle around the middle of the Earth.	
River	A natural stream of water that flows through land.	
Axis	An imaginary straight line around which Earth spins.	
Compass	A tool to help us find a direction.	
Village	A small settlement with a small number of houses for a few hundred people.	
Town	Larger than a village - they have more homes and more shops.	
City	The largest type of settlement, containing lots of buildings and lots of people.	
Port	A place at the edge of an ocean, river, or lake for ships to load and unload.	
Harbour	A place where ships may shelter. A port is also a harbour, but is usually bigger.
