

Science

Plants

We will continue to learn about plants by investigating the conditions that plants need to grow healthily, sorting seeds into different categories according to their size, shape and colour, exploring the similarities and differences in the growth of bulbs and seeds, dissecting seeds and learning about germination and recognising the bean life cycle.

Maths

Shape, patterns, lines and turns: Recognise and identify the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, understand the line of symmetry and recap rotational turns.

Graphs: Represent and interpret: pictograms, block diagrams, tables and tally charts.

Measures - Mass: Weigh and compare masses in kilograms and grams.

Music ***Exploring Improvisation***

We will be learning a new song called 'I Wanna Be in a Band'. We will be listening and responding to the music using our voices and instruments. We will be performing the song at the end of the unit.

Instruction Writing (Non-Fiction)

We will be exploring the features of instruction texts before creating and writing about our own magic potions. We will also be making delicious rice crispy cakes and writing our own instructions for you to use at home!

Snail and the Whale

We will be learning about the features of persuasive writing, writing the story in our own words and writing from a character's point of view by writing diary entries from the snail.

Computing ***Pictograms***

We will learn to collect data in the form of a tally chart. We will learn the term 'attribute' and use this to organise data. Finally, we will present data in the form of pictograms and block diagrams.

PE ***Swimming***

This term the children will be swimming every Friday.

PSHE ***Relationships***

This term we will be exploring our relationships with family and friends. We will recognise and appreciate people who can help us.

RE ***What does it mean to belong to a faith community?***

We will be exploring symbols of belonging for Christians, Muslims and Jewish people. We will learn how new babies are welcomed and identify ways people show they 'belong' to each other through marriage.

Art

This term we will be focussing on beach art. We will sketch pictures of beach huts focussing on bold lines. We will also be learning how to collage our own beach pictures, learning how to overlay and overlap materials for affect.

History

We will explore the British seaside during the 1960s and comparing it to our present time. We will identify how it has changed over time focussing on people's clothing, entertainment, souvenirs and the modes of transport people used to travel on to get to their destination.
