Science

Animals including Humans/Plants

We will continue to explore the importance of healthy lifestyles for humans including exercise and hygiene. We will then begin to learn about plants, exploring and investigating the conditions that plants need to grow healthily and learning how to sort seeds into different categories according to their size, shape and colour.

Maths

Fractions: We will learn how to find ½, ¼ and 1/3 of a shape and number.

Time: We will recap how to tell the time o'clock and half past before exploring quarter past and quarter to. By the end of the unit we will be telling the time in 5 minute intervals.

Measures – Length: We will learn how to draw, measure and compare lengths in metres and centimetres.

Music Recognising Different Sounds

We will be learning a new song called 'Helping Each Other'. We will be listening and responding to the music using our voices and instruments. We will be performing the song at the end of the unit.

Goldilocks and the Three Bears We will be learning how to retell the story using drama and drawing story maps. We will write the story in our own words before planning and writing our own alternative version.

We will learn to collect data in the form of a tally chart. We will discover the term 'attribute' and use this to organise data. Finally, we will present data in pictograms and block diagrams.

We will be learning key shapes, how to travel and balance. We will link it all together to create routines.

Healthy Me

We will be learning how to stay relaxed, how to eat a healthy balanced diet and how to use medicine safely. We will continue to revisit online and road safety.

How and why do we celebrate special and sacred times?

This term we will be learning about how and why Muslims celebrate Eid. We will then be exploring why Easter is significant and its importance for most Christians.

We will explore different shapes and materials to identify their stability including their strength and stiffness. We will then select and use different materials to create a stable chair for baby bear.

<u>Geography</u> 'Continents and Oceans'

We will be learning how to recognise, name and locate the 7 continents and 5 oceans on a world map. Additionally, we will be exploring amazing features of the world and identifying whether these are physical or human features. Finally, we will locate the equator and describe the environment and climate of equatorial areas.
