Everyday Materials

We will continue to distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made. We will recognise and compare the uses of and the suitability of a variety of different materials by performing simple scientific tests. We will learn how to gather data and record it in a simple chart.

Maths

Money: We will learn how to identify and recognise coins and notes, use £ and p accurately, add and subtract amounts and calculate change.

Multiplication and Division: We will explore multiplication and division through arrays, explore division as grouping and as sharing, connect multiplication and division facts using commutativity and inverse and calculate the times tables of 2, 5, and 10 using different strategies.

Autumn Poetry
