Good to know

- Examples of objects inside a home/in the street that can tell us about people and how they lived include furniture, number of vehicles, shop names, clothes.

- In many parts of the world, houses are made from mud and clay instead of bricks.
- Some cities around the world are very crowded and houses are squashed together.
- Sometimes more than one family might live in the same home.
