- Must Claim Benefits (Universal Credit, JSA, ESA, PIP, Income Support, Housing Benefits or any type of Tax Credit including Child Tax Credit). If you live in Merseyside, you do not need to claim any benefits.
- You Can't be a student or an international Student
- You Must have lived in the UK for a Minimum of 3 Years (Except if you are from the Ukraine).

Parking Issues

FOSP will be working alongside the school to shortly be implementing some deterrents to prevent parking on the zig zag and double-yellow lines outside the school entrance. This is an ongoing problem that affects many and we are looking to highlight the issues that come about when vehicles are parked illegally in this area. Ultimately, children's safety is put at risk by the issue; the area outside the school entrance is a heavy foot-traffic area, especially of vulnerable younger people, and the risk of injury or death is significant, caused by repeat offenders who we hope simply do not understand the seriousness of the risks that their parking creates. Our aim is to highlight the significance of their poor parking decisions in order to protect everyone. Plans will be actioned shortly, and please, think twice before parking where you shouldn't, even if it's only for a minute.
